## ANTIPHONS FOR THEOPHANY


January 6, Sundays from January 6 to 14.

## First Antiphon (Psalm 113, LXX), Verses in Second Tone:

- 1. When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language, Judah became His sanctuary.
- 2. The sea saw it and fled; Jordan turned back.
- 3. What ails you, O sea, that you fled? O Jordan, that you turned back? *Refrain: Through the Intercessions...*

## Second Antiphon (Psalm 114, LXX), Verses in Second Tone:

- 1. I love the Lord, because He has heard My voice and my supplications, because He has inclined His ear to me, therefore I will call upon Him as long as I live.
- 2. The pains of death surrounded me, And the pangs of Sheol laid hold of me.
- 3. Gracious is the Lord, and righteous; Yes, our God is merciful. *Refrain:*




Third Antiphon (Psalm 117, LXX), Verse (Intone in First Tone):

Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. *Chant the Apolytikion of Theophany. Then...* 

## SMALL ENTRANCE HYMN FOR THEOPHANY

On the feast, segue immediately to the 2nd antiphon refrain above, "O Son of God, baptized in the Jordan by John...," or on the leave-taking, segue immediately to the standard 2nd antiphon refrain, "O Son of God, Who arose from the dead...."
