

Third Antiphon (Psalm 117, LXX)


Verse (Intoned in First Tone):


SMALL ENTRANCE HYMN FOR THEOPHANY

On the leave-taking, or if January 7 is on a Sunday, segue immediately to the standard 2nd antiphon refrain, "Soson imas, Ie Theou, o anastas ek nekron..."



On January 6 and 7, segue immediately to the 2nd antiphon refrain on the reverse side of this page, "O Son of God, baptized in the Jordan...," or...

On the leave-taking, or if January 7 is on a Sunday, segue immediately to the standard 2nd antiphon refrain, "O Son of God, Who arose from the dead...."

Repeat the Apolytikion of Theophany, and other apolytikia, if any.
