- 3. Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.






# Third Antiphon (Psalm 71, LXX)

Έσται τὸ ὄνομα αὐτοῦ εὐλογημένον εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας. His name shall endure forever.


