ANTIPHONS FOR THE TRANSFIGURATION OF CHRIST


August 6, Sundays from August 6 to 13.

First Antiphon (Psalms 47, 64, and 103, LXX), Verses in Second Tone:

- 1. Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised In the city of our God, in His holy mountain.
- 2. Who established the mountains by His strength.
- 3. You are clothed with honor and majesty, Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment. *Refrain: Through the Intercessions...*

Second Antiphon (Psalm 86, LXX), Verses in Second Tone:

- 1. His foundation is in the holy mountains. The Lord loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob.
- 2. Glorious things are spoken of you, O city of God!
- 3. And of Zion it will be said, "This one and that one were born in her." *Refrain*:




Third Antiphon (Psalm 88, LXX), Verse (Intone in Grave Tone):

The heavens will praise Your wonders, O Lord.

Chant the Apolytikion of the Transfiguration of Christ. Then...

On the leave-taking, segue immediately to the standard 2nd antiphon refrain, "O Son of God, Who arose from the dead...."
