- 2. Έτοιμάζων ὄρη ἐν τῆ ἰσχύϊ αὐτοῦ.
- 3. Αναβαλλόμενος φῶς ὡς ἱμάτιον. Τὰ ὄρη ἀγαλλιάσονται ἀπὸ προσώπου Κυρίου.


Verses (Intone in Second Tone):




## Third Antiphon (Psalm 88, LXX)

Chant the Apolytikion of the Transfiguration of Christ. Then...


