

ANTIPHONS FOR PALM SUNDAY

First Antiphon (Psalm 114, LXX)

Verses (*Intone in Second Tone*):

1. Ἡγάπησα, ὅτι εἰσακούσεται Κύριος τῆς φωνῆς τῆς δεήσεώς μου, ὅτι ἔκλινε τὸ οὖς αὐτοῦ ἐμοί, καὶ ἐν ταῖς ἡμέραις μου ἐπικαλέσομαι.
2. Περιέσχον με ὡδῖνες θανάτου, κίνδυνοι ἄδου εὗροσάν με.
3. Θλίψιν καὶ ὀδύνην εὗρον, καὶ τὸ ὄνομα Κυρίου ἐπεκαλεσάμην.

Second Antiphon (Psalm 115, LXX)

Verses (*Intone in Second Tone*):

3. I will take up the cup of salvation, And call upon the name of the Lord.

Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.
