

## ANTIPHONS FOR PENTECOST

Pentecost and Bright Week


### First Antiphon (Psalms 18, LXX), Verses in Second Tone:

1. Make a joyful shout to God, all the earth!
  2. Sing out the honor of His name; make His praise glorious.
  3. Say to God, "How awesome are Your works!" All the earth shall worship You and sing praises to You.
- Refrain: Through the Intercessions of the Theotokos, Savior, save us.*

### Second Antiphon (Psalms 19, LXX), Verses in Second Tone:

1. God be merciful to us and bless us, and cause His face to shine upon us
2. That Your way may be known on earth, Your salvation among all nations.
3. Let the peoples praise You, O God; let all the peoples praise You.

*Refrain:*


