

ANTIPHONS FOR THE RESURRECTION

Most Sundays

First Antiphon (Psalm 102, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Εύλόγει, ἡ ψυχή μου, τὸν κύριον καὶ πάντα τὰ ἐντός μου, τὸ δόνομα τὸ ἅγιον αὐτοῦ.
2. Εύλόγει, ἡ ψυχή μου, τὸν κύριον καὶ μὴ ἐπιλανθάνου πάσας τὰς ἀνταποδόσεις αὐτοῦ.
3. Κύριος ἐν τῷ οὐρανῷ ἡτοίμασεν τὸν θρόνον αὐτοῦ, καὶ ἡ βασιλεία αὐτοῦ πάντων δεσπόζει.

Refrain: Ταῖς πρεσβείαις τῆς Θεοτόκου...

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me bless his holy name.
2. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits.
3. The Lord has prepared his throne in the heavens; and His kingdom rules over all.

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos...

Second Antiphon (Psalms 145, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Αἴνει, ἡ ψυχή μου, τὸν κύριον· αἰνέσω κύριον ἐν τῇ ζωῇ μου, ψαλῶ τῷ θεῷ μου, ἔως ὑπάρχω.
2. Μακάριος οὐδὲ θεὸς Ἰακώβ βοηθός αὐτοῦ, ἡ ἐλπὶς αὐτοῦ ἐπὶ κύριον τὸν θεὸν αὐτοῦ.
3. Βασιλεύσει κύριος εἰς τὸν αἰώνα, ὁ θεός σου, Σιων, εἰς γενεὰν καὶ γενεάν.

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

1. Praise the Lord, O my soul. While I live will I praise the Lord; I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being.
2. Happy is he that has the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the Lord his God.
3. The Lord shall reign for ever; even your God, O Zion, unto all generations.

Third Antiphon (Psalm 117, LXX)

Amen and Verse (Intoned in Tone of the Apolytikion):

Αὕτη ἡ ἡμέρα, ἣν ἐποίησεν ὁ κύριος· ἀγαλλιασώμεθα καὶ εὐφρανθῶμεν ἐν αὐτῇ.

This is the day the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Chant the apolytikion of the day. Then...
