ANTIPHONS FOR SAINTS (Most weekdays)

First Antiphon (Psalm 91, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):
1. It is good to give thanks to the Lord, and to sing praises to Your name, O Most High.
2. Declare Your loving kindness in the morning, and Your faithfulness every night.
3. Declare that the Lord is upright; He is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos...


Second Antiphon (Psalms 92, LXX)

Verses (Intone in Second Tone):

 The Lord reigns, He is clothed with majesty; The Lord is clothed, He has girded Himself with strength.
 Surely the world is established, so that it cannot be moved.

3. Holiness adorns Your house, O Lord, forever.

Refrain:



Third Antiphon (Psalm 94, LXX)

Verse (Intoned in Tone of the Apolytikion):

Oh come, let us sing to the Lord! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation.

Chant the apolytikion of the day. Then...

SMALL ENTRANCE HYMN FOR SAINTS

(Same as Sundays, but ending with "...wondrous in Your saints..." instead of "...risen from the dead...")

Repeat the apolytikion of the day and other apolytikia, if any.
